BREAKING THE SILENCE

Clark Fredericks shares his story as a survivor of unspeakable abuse at the hands of a trusted family friend who was employed as a County Sheriff's Lieutenant for years.

To alleviate his pain, Clark became dependent on alcohol, drugs and gambling while remaining silent for over thirty years. One day in 2012, it would all come to a head when Clark killed his abuser.

Since his release from State Prison 2016, Clark has devoted his time to helping others deal with the same torment he suffered. Clark's message offers support and guidance to others letting them know they are not alone, "Breaking the Silence".

THE EVENTS

In this five-part online series, Clark's message details the horror he suffered during his childhood and what went wrong by remaining silent. Clark will also share how his life went right, through recovery.

His firsthand experience, along with his guest's commentary, will provide valuable information on how to keep our children and communities safe. A live question and answer period will be conducted after each segment

This series will encourage people to reclaim their lives and mend relationships with the ones they love. A subject of interest to Kiwanis given its mission to "improving the lives of children one community at a time" and the theme of our event, "Breaking the Silence"..

PART 1 - AWARENESS & RESPONSIBILITY August 6, 2020 at 7:00PM

What may appear to be a casual relationship between an adult and child may be a sinister attempt to injure the innocent.

To better protect children from possible abuse, parents and others responsible for the care of a young person, should be aware of certain information when communicating with a victim.

The discussion will focus on "Grooming", a predator's premeditated plan of action to gain the trust and confidence of a young child over time in order to advance their deviant conduct.

Retired State Police Crime Scene Investigator, Howie Ryan will be Clark's guest. He will share Law Enforcement's recommendations when dealing with this issue

PART 2 - HEALING August 13. 2020 at 7:00PM

Survivors of abuse often bury their pain, remaining silent for decades in an effort to push away the shame and hurt they have suffered.

Breaking the silence and openly addressing the degree of injury one has suffered is the critical first phase of the healing process - something Clark dealt with firsthand.

Appearing with Clark to offer guidance in this area will be a therapist from Ginny's House, a Children's advocacy center in Sussex County.

PART 3 ADDICTION & SUBSTANCE ABUSE August 20, 2020 at 7:00PM

A staggering number of abuse survivors turn to drugs, alcohol and other forms of addictive behavior.

Young people should hear Clark's story of recovery. While the young are developing their minds and emotions, there is no room for alcohol and drug use, yet this is a popular place to turn for kids who are suffering.

Clark's guests this session are Executive Director of Absolute Awakenings, Ms. Kim Vytell and John Michaud, Executive Director for Community Service New Pathway.

Kim is a licensed Clinician who has recovered from the path of addiction and knows first-hand what treatment can do for a person who seeks to better themselves.

PART 4 - EARLY TREATMENT FOR CHANGE August 27, 2020 at 7:00PM

Early action to effect positive changes in development lead to the best outcomes for babies and children.

Parents are often advised by their pediatricians to take a "wait and see approach" to a child's motor development. Sometimes they are told that their child will outgrow a motor concern over time. We strongly disagree with this guidance, and believe the longer a child waits for intervention, the more difficult it becomes to make change.

Lisa Kaufman, Pediatric Physical Therapist joins Clark. Lisa has over 27 years of experience working with children diagnosed with a variety of orthopedic and neurological disorders.

PART 5 AVOIDING TROUBLE & POSSIBLE INCARCERATION

September 3, 2020 at 7:00PM

Pain turns to anger and anger always finds trouble.

Without confronting the pain and dealing with the issues attendant to abuse, many end up in the prison system. Most don't realize the negative long term impacts of being involved in criminal behavior.

From finding a job, or the crushing blow it deals to family members, this is an issue that needs to be discussed.
